Dr. Dobrowlosky received her B.A. (hons.) from Toronto, her M.A. from Dalhousie University, and her Ph.D. from Carleton University (completing her thesis, entitled "The Politics of Pragmatism: Women, Strategic Representation, and Constitutionalism in Canada" in 1996). She joined the faculty at St. Mary's University in 2000 as Assistant Professor of Political Science, became Associate Professor in 2003 and Professor in 2008.

Fonds consists of research reports, briefs, notes, and articles on the topic of the Meech Lake Accord, Charlottetown Accord, the Canadian Constitution and Constitutional reform surrounding women and the law.
